REPORT FOR 2025

STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

We started the year with our first project in Feb.

On the 8th of February, we were at Abeokuta for Love4JAMB. We had 4 students in attendance and we paid for their exam fees.

On the 15th of February, we had the Ibadan Love4JAMB. 26 students were in attendance from Tabitha, Oyiza, LIWOM, Oluyole High School and Basorun Ogunmola. All their fees were paid for. A total of 30 students had their JAMB fee paid for.

Impact: all the students in the homes passed well especially the students at Tabitha. They all got admission into tertiary institutions.

Our second project for the year is business grants for single mothers and widows (BGSMW). In April, we sought applications from women as to what they would use their grants for. 6 women benefited this year getting N30,000.00 each. There was business training on the topic: Fundamentals of starting and scaling a business by Mrs. Funmi Olabisi

Impact: one of the women, Preshflour Naturals was able to start packaging her plantain flour, Ajani Morakinyo got more materials for her fabric production.

Our third project for the year is beautifying His jewels (BHJ). This held on the 25th of May. We visited three homes and gave them cake, drinks, food and other essentials needs. It was a great time with the children. We encouraged them and gave the supplies. Total of 110 children and 10 care givers were impacted.

Our fourth project is Back- to-school (BTS). It held on the 23rd of July. We visited Lam Adesina Model School to give 124 pupils exercise books and stationeries. All the pupils were given these items and a lot of them were motivated to look forward to resumption for the new session.

Our sixth project – children praise and pray in Nigeria held on the 2nd of August, where 150 children and 50 adults were fed. We sang, danced and prayed, had quizzes and gifts were given to winners. This year, Fan Milk and Precious Heritage supported us with products. The children had lots of yoghurt, milo drink and coco pops to take. Sumal also gave us 10 packs of biscuits, of which we took to the UK for CPP UK.

Similarly, on the 16th of August, the second edition of CPP held in Coventry, UK. It was a great event with 30 children and 20 adults in attendance. Gifts were given to winners of games and quizzes, drinks and snacks given to all attendees.

The last project tagged Pad our beauties held on the 10th of October in celebration of International Day of the Girl Child. We visited youths of HOSEI for an advocacy on menstrual health and hygiene and gave out 100 sanitary towels. On the 16th, we were at United Missionary School, Molete to give a talk on Teenage pregnancy, its hazards and need for purity with Shecares; 100 sanitary towels were also given out. We gave out 50 sanitary towels to Girls with dreams.

We got a grant of N150,000.00 to support our Pad our beauties project.

In February, we opened our space up for free library for children to come every Saturday between the hours of 10am and 2pm. The children are always eager to read and learn new things.

On the 20th of December, we shared love at Christmas and gave 100 vulnerable children food packs in two markets – Challenge and Orita Challenge.

Our President won an award (Humanitarian of the year) by Nigeria Women achievers Award. She also won Integrity award by Gani Fawehinmi Awards. She got nominated for Top 20 changemakers by Luminary Project. She was also recognized as one of the top50 emerging visible African women by ShePremium Africa.

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REPORT FOR 2024

STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

We started the year with our first project in Feb.

On the 10th of February, we were at Abeokuta for Love4JAMB. We had 3 students in attendance and we paid for their exam fees.

On the 11th of February, we had the Ibadan Love4JAMB. 19 students were in attendance from Tabitha, Oyiza, LIWOM, Oluyole High School and Basorun Ogunmola. All their fees were paid for. A total of 24 students had their JAMB fee paid for.

Impact: all the students in the homes passed well especially the students at Tabitha. They got admission into tertiary institutions.

Our second project for the year is business grants for single mothers and widows (BGSMW). We sought applications from women as to what they would use their grants for. 5 women benefited this year getting N30,000.00 each.

Impact: one of the women, Double Fruity zobo drinks, used the grant to get bottles for proper packaging for her drinks. Others had growth in their businesses.

Our third project for the year is beautifying His jewels (BHJ). This held on the 26th of May. We visited three homes and gave them cake, drinks, food and other essentials needs. It was a great time with the children. We encouraged them and gave them supplies.

Our fourth project is Back- to-school (BTS). It held on the 31st of July. We visited Lam Adesina Model School to give 100 pupils exercise books and stationeries.

As a result of this project, we got support from Luminary project and we were able to give 53 students of Oluyole High School, textbooks on the 2nd of October.

Our sixth project – children praise and pray in Nigeria held on the 3rd of August, where 150 children and 50 adults were fed. We sang, danced and prayed, had quizzes and gifts were given to winners.

Similarly, on the 17th of August, the maiden edition of CPP held in Coventry, UK. It was a great event with 25 children and 15 adults in attendance. Gifts were given to winners of games and quizzes, drinks and snacks given to all attendees.

In September, on the 19th, we were selected to participate in a program organized by Kings College London and Afe Babalola Centre for transformational Education to discuss issues around education in the country.

The last project tagged pad our beauties held on the 11th of October in celebration of International Day of the Girl Child. We visited youths of HOSEI for an advocacy on menstrual health and hygiene and gave out 100 sanitary towels. We also partnered with Girls with dreams to give out 100 sanitary towels.

We ended the year with a grant of N200,000.00 planned for use towards our Love4JAMB 2025.

We also got books from our partner in the UK. Dr. Ebehi. This was put in our office to resuscitate Jackies hub for children to come in and read for free.

Likewise, we got donation of 81 storybooks from Mrs Tomisin Ogunseyinde, which will be used next year for our Jackies hub and back to school project.

The NGO won an award for NGO of the year (Empowerment/Skill acquisition) by Nigeria Women achievers Award. She got nominated for Most Outstanding Health community service of the year award by Dove Healthcare awards. Our President won some awards too.

FISWS – a capacity building project is sponsored by OFI won an award by Blingzawards. It held on the 3rd of June and it was a great success.
